GUIDELINES FOR VISITORS, FUNERALS, AND OTHER GATHERINGS AT BROCKLANDS DURING THE CORONAVIRUS PANDEMIC

- These Coronavirus Guidelines have been amended by Government with effect from 16th December 2021.
- Visitors to Brocklands are welcome during normal opening hours (in other words during daylight hours) and you don't have to contact us prior to visiting.
- There is no longer a limit on the number of people who can attend a funeral. Instead the number will be determined by how many people the venue can safely accommodate. In effect this means at Brocklands any number may attend outside, whilst the number in the Haybarn will continue to be restricted to 25.
- Use of the Haybarn is permitted for use prior to and following a burial. The maximum number of people allowed in the building is 25, which allows for appropriate social distancing. Hand sanitisers and hand-washing facilities are available in the Haybarn and people are required by law to wear face coverings (unless they are exempt) when attending a function in the building.
- The provision and serving of refreshments will be allowed subject to the same restrictions on numbers as set out above. Face coverings are not required in the Haybarn whilst food and drink are being consumed, however face coverings are recommended whilst moving around the venue.
- Linked ceremonial events (such as tree plantings) can be held subject to the same restrictions as set out above.
- **Anyone showing symptoms** or living in a household with anyone who is showing symptoms of Covid-19, will be asked to stay away from any funeral at Brocklands. Families are requested to make the staff aware of any attendees who are in the Covid-19 high-risk category, so that appropriate measures may be taken to minimise risk to them.
- **Mourners attending a funeral** are requested to follow Government guidelines on personal hygiene and social distancing. Toilet and hand-washing facilities are available for those attending a funeral and for visitors.

These guidelines have been drawn up according to the Government order as of 23/03/2020, updated 16/12/2021.
